- 1) March quarterly meetings minutes;
  - Heather McAvoy moved to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Seconded by Joanne Lehner and unanimously approved.
- 2) February/March/April budgets; 3rd quarter capital improvement expense reports
  - Account 5861 did not include the cost of the DDW requirements.
  - Account 5849 accrued expenses from the cross connection program.
  - Account 7412 expense is County staff time working on implementing the seismic retrofit. This cost will be reimbursed by account 2521; general fund per County.
- 3) Capital improvement; Compliance
  - County to send Joanne Lehner water test results.
  - Since DDW issued citation. Water Works created a resolution to fix the problem properly.
  - County replied to public comment from last meeting (Recommends moving outlet pipe onto storage tank to circulate water in tank to help reduce TTHM). Not a viable solution.
  - The timeline given to DDW by County; the capital projects will be competed once CSA7 received proper funding.
  - Bids for the seismic retrofit project are due in July. Project complete by year end 2016.
  - Bracewell contract includes an 8% increase.

## 4) Income survey

• Received enough responses for the survey census. CSA7 does not qualify for the disadvantaged communities funding. Deborah will follow up on final report.
